- Slide 8: **Quote Analysis** (identify, explain, and analyze a moment for its significance!)
- Slide 9: **Text-Based Arguments** (creating supported opinions of the text)
- Slide 10: **Blank Template** (for you to customize for another purpose!)

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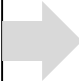
